LOCAL PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZERS RESCUE THE SAN DIEGO RESCUE MISSION WAREHOUSE

SAN DIEGO, CA—On January 29, 2007, the San Diego chapter of the National Association of Professional Organizers (**NAPO-SD**) will donate their time, energies and organizing skills to help the local non-profit agency San Diego Rescue Mission (SDRM). This outreach and generous donation of time and professional resources is in participation with *GO Month (Get Organized Month)* a national industry-wide event.

NAPO-SD will create a space-efficient layout and design for the 15,000 sq. ft. warehouse operated by the SDRM. In January, over twenty local Professional Organizers will converge on the warehouse to create systems and streamlined processes that will expedite inventory to the three local thrift stores operated by the SDRM.
